SAMPLE SENTENCES

私は留学生です。 <i>Watashi wa ryūgakusei desu.</i> I'm a foreign exchange student.	いいえ、ちがいます。 <i>iie, chigaimasu.</i> No, that's wrong.
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GRAMMAR

Useful Vocabulary and Phrases:

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iie, chigaimasu. (いいえ、違います。)

iie (いいえ) = no

Chigaimasu (ちがいます。) = That's wrong. (literally means "It is different")

An affirmative response is " *Hai, sō desu.* (はい、そうです。)

→Yes, that's right."

hai (はい) = Yes.

sō desu (そうです) = That's right. (literally means "It is so.")

* *ō* (そう) can be used instead of repeating the noun.

Example :

これはくすりですか。

Kore wa kusuri desu ka?

Is this medicine?
